Weekly Comments:

6/14 - In last's week's World Supply Demand report, the USDA increased its ethanol demand forecast by 3% for 2009/10 and by 2% for 2010/11. As a result, U.S. 2010/11 corn ending stocks were reduced from 1.82 to 1.57B bushels, and world ending stocks were cut from 154 to 147M tons. Corn futures, which had bottomed at \$3.35 on last Monday, bounced back to \$3.49 by week's end. The bullish USDA report pushed the expected trading range to \$3.40-3.80 per bushel. = = Coffee futures spiked to \$1.4495 on Friday after the International Coffee Organization forecast 2010/11 coffee output at 34M bags, and projected 2010 world consumption also at 134M. Tight world supplies, the impending Brazilian winter and rumors that the Vietnamese are holding back Robusta exports have combined to put upward pressure on coffee prices.
